### PROGRAMS AT A GLANCE

Staying true to our mission, HSC offers a variety of programs and player pathways to fulfill the goals and expectations of each player and their family. These offerings fall into three main parent programs where we strive to offer the premier experience in the area while fulfilling the overall goals of each. In all our programs, we strive to give more for less when comparing to other options in the area.

#### HSC Recreational Programs

- Consists of programs designed to maximize fun, teach players the basics, and help them develop a life-long love of the game
- Includes grassroots program that is the biggest feeder of other HSC programs.
- Facilitated by volunteer coaches under the direction and leadership of our Recreational Director
- Additional bridge program available to help facilitate grassroots players into the appropriate pathway (Phantoms Foundation Program)

#### HSC Competitive Programs

- Consists of programs dedicated to the complete development of the competitive soccer player
- Offers the best value with more sessions at a lesser cost than all other local comparable programs – all U10 and older teams train 3 times per week
- Incorporation of dedicated Technical, Speed & Agility, and Goalkeeper training into curriculum
- Annual feedback and evaluations for all ages for feedback and improvement
- Option to compete for Alabama State Cup Championship paid for by the club

#### HVS Competitive Programs

- Consists of programs created to provide the highest levels of competition across premier regional and national leagues
- Provides resources and opportunities to expose players to opportunities in soccer after high school graduation
- Opportunity to compete at the highest youth levels in the country
- Cooperation of sister clubs Hoover Soccer Club and Vestavia Hills Soccer Club along with area affiliates creates strength in numbers
- Specialized training for goalkeepers
- MLS Next option that practices 4 times per week and plays as a team year-round

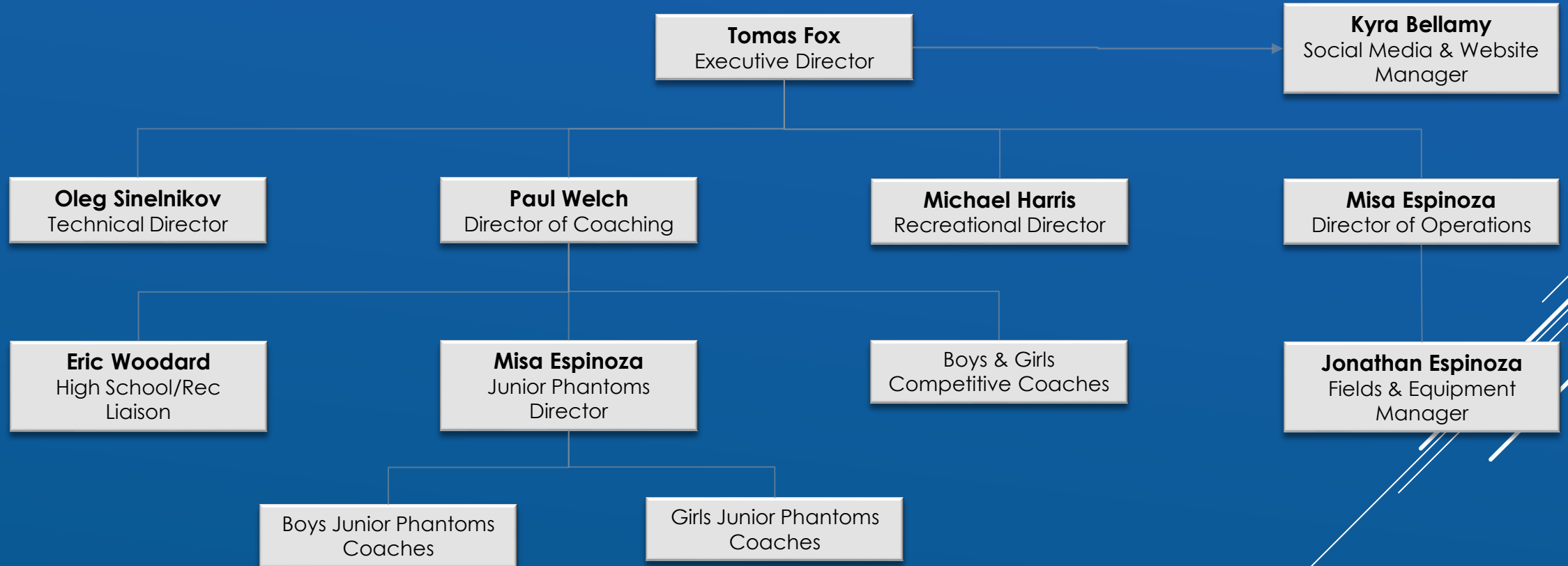

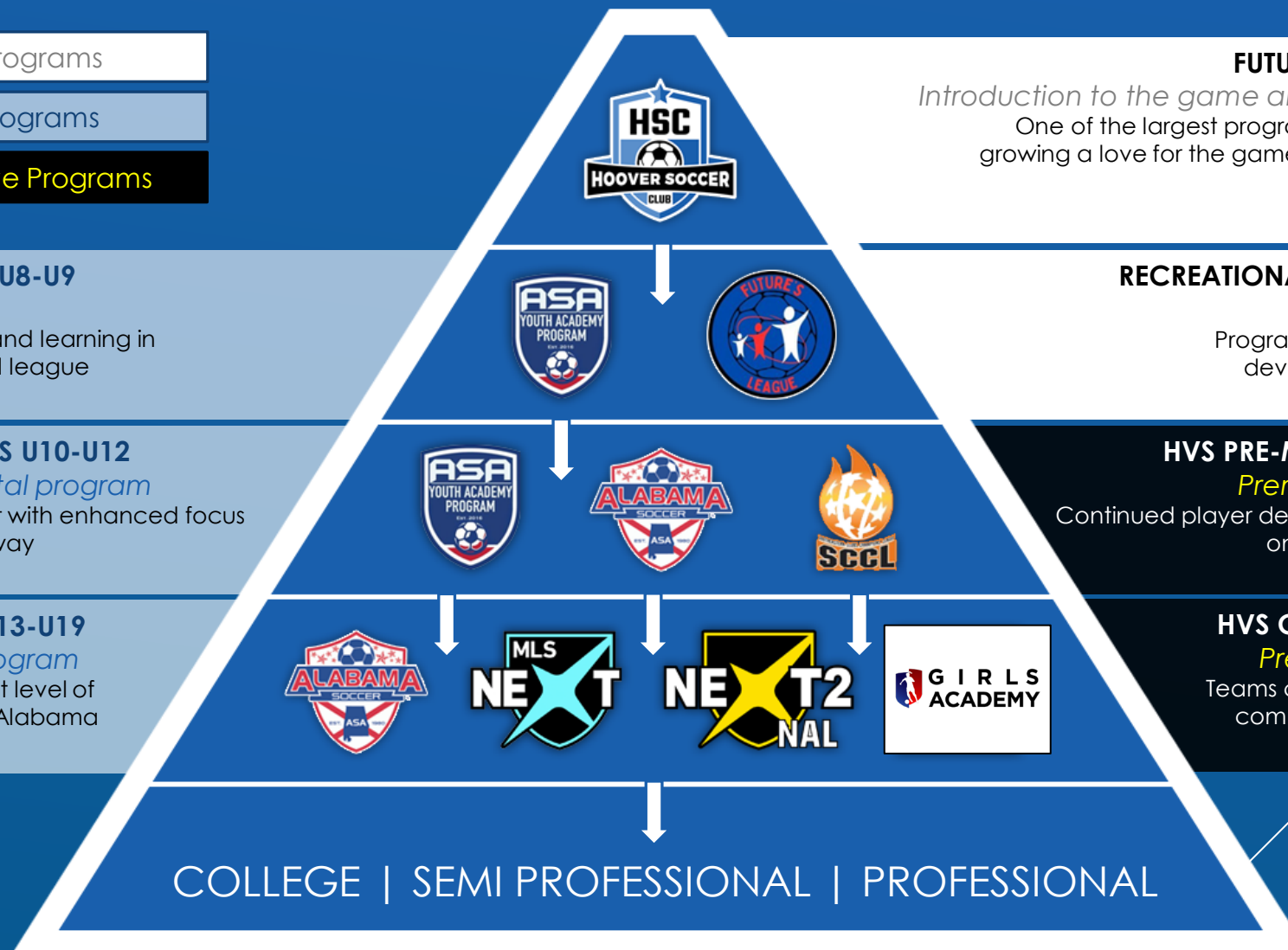

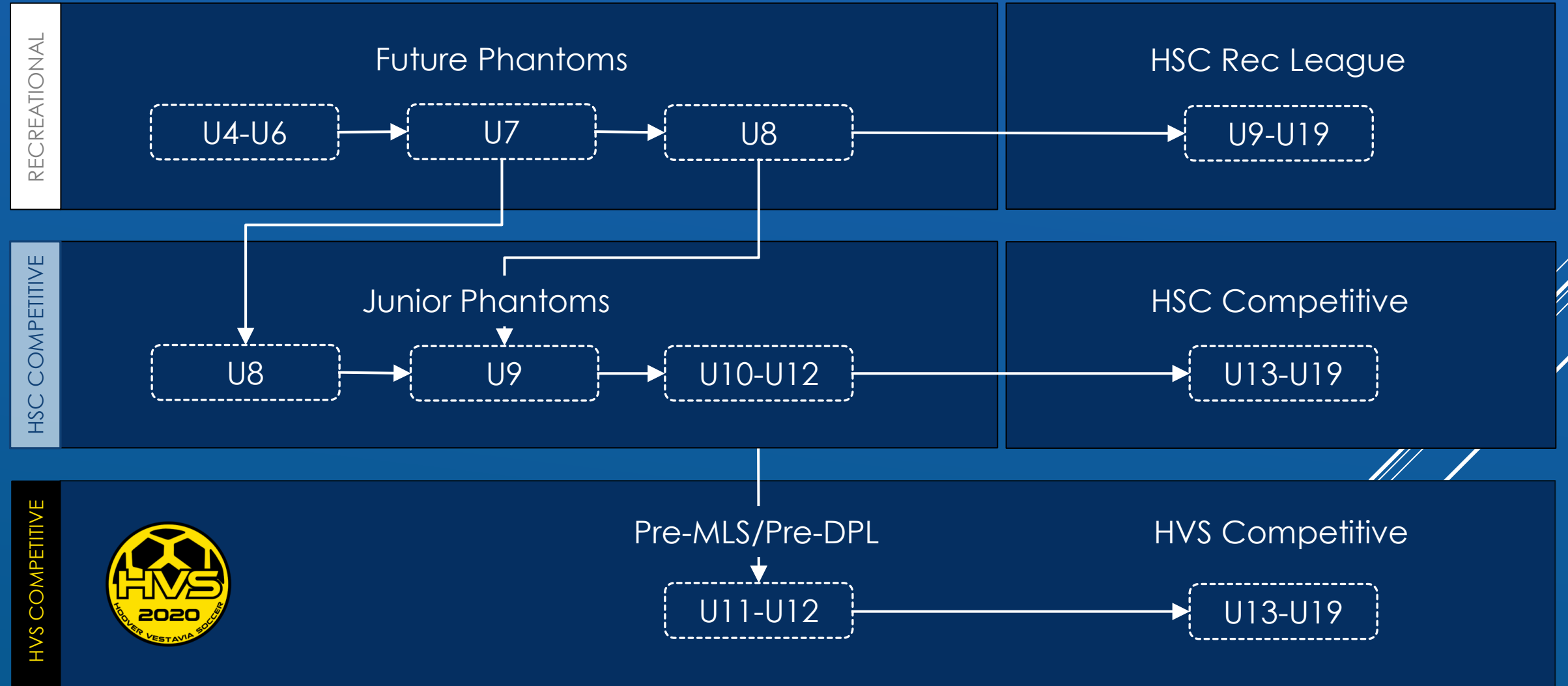

- Focus on age-appropriate fundamentals
- Introduction to next 7v7 stage of the game
- Instill a love of the game via focus on learning and development

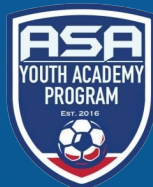
## DEVELOPMENTAL



### JUNIOR PHANTOMS

*Ages U8-U9*

- Entry level competitive program with primary focus on player development
- Experienced staff coaching
- Age-appropriate curriculum
- Team training 2 times per week
- Additional technical, speed, and agility training available
- Participation in local D-League
- Local tournament participation



### JUNIOR PHANTOMS II

*Ages U10-U12*

- Continued focus on player development with emphasis on tactical and competitive awareness
- Increase to 3 team training sessions per week
- Integration of more advanced technical, speed, and agility topics
- Participation in local D-League or Alabama State League
- Local and possible regional tournament participation



### HVS PRE-MLS/PRE-DPL

*Ages U11-U12*

- Premier player development program with our sister club Hoover-Vestavia Soccer
- Advanced development environment with greater emphasis on tactical and competitive awareness
- Training sessions 3 times per week
- Participation in Alabama State League at U11 and Regional SSCL league at U12
- Local and possible regional tournament participation

- **U13-U14:** Full year with Fall and Spring seasons
- **U15-U19:** Fall season only (due to spring school soccer)
- Some travel required with mostly in-state and some tournaments
- Exposure to collegiate recruiters

*Ages U13-U19*

- Competitive program with teams competing at the highest levels regionally and nationally
- Elite player and talent development
- Highest level of competitive leagues available in US Soccer
- **Boys:** MLS Next & Next 2/NAL leagues
- **Girls:** Girls Academy (GA)
- National/Regional and state travel required
- Maximum exposure to collegiate and professional recruiters
